Board President Peggy Jo Kennett presided and conducted. The Board of Education met in a study session to discuss the following issues:

**A. Student Transportation**

This item is a continued discussion from a previous study session. Mr. Jim Hinckle again reviewed for the Board the District-funded hazardous bus routes. Jordan District currently has about 87 hazardous routes, at an annual cost of about \$1.34 million. Mr. Hinckle was seeking Board direction for 2010-11 regarding their intention to continue funding hazardous routes, how many routes, and at what budget level. As part of this discussion, the Transportation Department sought Board direction on how many potential hazardous routes should be reviewed by an independent third party to determine the relative hazard of each potential route. The Board decided not to conduct any studies at this time.

**B. Process for Naming New High School in Herriman**

Ms. Sherry Wasden reviewed the process and timeline for naming a new school. Her proposed timeline would allow the Board to name the new high school by November 10, 2009.

**C. BoardDocs Training**

Superintendent Newbold asked the Board members if there was a need for additional BoardDocs training. The consensus was to wait and decide at a future meeting.

**D. Board Issues and Concerns**

Board Members discussed various issues and concerns.
